About NEET (UG) 2026

The **National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET-UG) 2026** is the common national entrance examination conducted by the **National Testing Agency (NTA)** for admission to undergraduate medical education in India. It is applicable for admission to **MBBS, BDS and other courses as prescribed by the respective statutory authorities.**

1. Eligibility Criteria

Admission to the **Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)** programme shall be subject to the candidate fulfilling the eligibility requirements prescribed by the **National Medical Commission (NMC), National Testing Agency (NTA), Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), Government of India, the affiliating University and other competent authorities.**

1.1 Educational Qualification

The candidate must:

- Have passed **10+2 / Higher Secondary examination** from a recognized Board.
- Have studied **Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology** as prescribed for medical education.
- Fulfill the minimum qualifying requirements prescribed under the applicable NMC regulations.
- Qualify in **NEET (UG)** conducted by the National Testing Agency.
- Fulfill the applicable age and other eligibility requirements prescribed for the relevant academic year. -

NEET (UG) is the common and uniform entrance examination for admission to undergraduate medical education in medical institutions in India.

1.2 NEET Qualification

Candidates must qualify NEET (UG) in accordance with the qualifying criteria and percentile prescribed by the competent authority for the relevant admission year

1.3 Category-wise Eligibility

Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwBD and other categories shall be eligible for applicable reservation/relaxation only on production of valid certificates in the prescribed format

1.4 NRI/OCI/Foreign Candidates

NRI/OCI/foreign national candidates, wherever eligible, shall comply with the applicable Government, NMC, MCC and counselling authority requirements and produce the prescribed supporting documents.

Important: Meeting the minimum eligibility criteria does not guarantee admission. Admission is based on NEET merit, counselling, seat availability and applicable regulations.

2. Admission Procedure

Admission to the MBBS programme shall be made **only through the prescribed NEET-UG counseling process** and in accordance with the rules applicable to the particular category of seat.

The general admission process is:

1. Appear for **NEET (UG)**.
2. Obtain the NEET score/rank.
3. Register for the applicable counseling.
4. Participate in choice filling and choice locking.
5. Receive seat allotment.
6. Download the provisional seat allotment letter.
7. Report to the allotted medical college within the prescribed period.
8. Produce original documents for verification.
9. Pay the prescribed tuition and other applicable fees.
10. Complete the college admission and joining formalities.
11. Obtain confirmation of admission.

For seats covered under MCC counselling, candidates must follow the instructions and schedule published by MCC. MCC currently operates the UG Medical Counselling process for applicable MBBS/BDS seats.

3.1 Mode of Payment
