**ORDER:-**

The Tamil Nadu Private Universities Act, 2019 (Tamil Nadu Act No.14 of 2019) has been enacted and the same has been brought into force on 08.07.2019 and the Tamil Nadu Private University Rules, 2019 has also been notified in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary on 08.07.2019.

2. The sponsoring body viz. Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Charitable and Educational Trust in the letter second read above has submitted a detailed proposal for establishment of a Private University in the name of "Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan University" at Samayapuram, Tiruchirappalli alongwith the Challan receipt for Rs.12,00,000/-, dated 30.08.2019.

3. Based on the report of the Expert Committee constituted vide Government letter third read above, the Government, in their letter fourth read above, issued Letter of Intent informing the sponsoring body viz. Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Charitable and Educational Trust, the Intent of the Government to permit establishment of a Private University by the name "Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan University" at Samayapuram, Tiruchirappalli, subject to fulfillment of the conditions stipulated in section 4 of the said Act and all other conditions or requirements as stipulated in that Act and the Rules made thereunder.

4. The Chairman, Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Charitable and Educational Trust in his letter fifth read above has stated that the Trust has fulfilled the conditions stipulated in section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Private Universities Act, 2019 and all other conditions or requirements as stipulated in the said Act and the Rules made thereunder, and as in the Letter of Intent issued by the Government on 10.09.2020 for the establishment of new Private University in the name and style of "Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan University" at Samayapuram, Tiruchirappalli and sent the details and documents relating to the conditions fulfilled by the Trust for consideration. He has, therefore, requested the Government to make necessary arrangements to include the name of the University viz. "Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan University" in the Schedule of the Tamil Nadu Private Universities Act, 2019 with details of location by way of amendment to the Schedule, as per section 9 of the said Act.

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chairman, Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Charitable and Educational Trust in para 4 above.

6. Accordingly, the following notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary :-
